BY-LAW NO. 2024-23

TO CONFIRM THE PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL AT ITS MEETING HELD ON APRIL 25, 2024

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
